Abbreviations Used for Genetic Clearance Information

Certification that a dog is genetically clear of a disease is shown as follows:

"DNA {(disease)}/{(from of disease)}"

Example: DNA (PRA/RCD1) denotes the absence of rod-cone dysplasia (RCD1), the form of Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA) affecting Irish Setters.
